When fortunate enough to have a powerful trump suit and being forced to ruff, tend not to ruff with your lowest trump. That tiny trump might be your only way to get to dummy.

Burn's law of total trumps

When you are declarer, the total number of trumps held by your side should be greater than the total number of trumps held by the opponents (invented by British expert David Burn).
