#### **People**

NZ Bridge Annual Congress – Thanks Jan for the report



Congress was held on 1st – 8th October at Bay Park - Mt Maunganui a new venue for the event which worked well. This year it was good to see congress come back to face-to-face play as over 650 players descended on the Mount. All Grades were represented from Open to Novice and as players took their seats the battle commenced.

Four players from our Warkworth Club attended. These were Graeme Duhs, Steve Moore, Alan and Jan France who over the course of 4 days played 204 boards. The competition was

tough, but we hung in there. The first day, Swiss Pairs (52 boards) Graeme and Steve came 14th, well played, and Alan and Jan 66th out of 82 pairs. On the second day only Graeme and Steve played in the Intermediate Pairs (56 boards) coming in 34th out of 70 pairs with a very respectable 49.26%. Jan and Alan took a break and visited the hot pools. The final event of Congress was the 2-day Teams events played over 8 sessions of 12 boards. Making a total of 96 boards played on Friday and Saturday. We were all entered in the Intermediate Teams event and Graeme and Steve paired up with Rosemary and Takayo from East Coast Bays, they came 17th. Jan and Alan paired with Ann and Joe from Royale Epsom and managed to stay off the bottom of the ladder, just, coming 27th out of 30.

#### **Tournaments**

Our 2 Junior and 2 Intermediate teams in the Auckland Northland Regional Competition are all still playing well. Results will be available next newsletter. Several pairs are also playing in an NZ Bridge pairs competition online on a Sunday evening – 10 sessions over 8 months – again the results will be out next newsletter.
